### *Judges Cup:*

The Victors Gymnastics Team of Greece competed in the New York State Judges Cup hosted by Victors Gymnastics, November 22 – 23 in Rochester, NY. The Victors' Team placed third overall in the Optional team competition.



### *Pinky Stone Memorial:*

The Victors Gymnastics Team of Greece competed in the Pinky Stone Memorial hosted by Central New York Gymnastics, December 5 – 6 at the OnCenter in Syracuse, NY. The Victors' Team placed second overall in the Level 7 and Level 8 team competitions.

In the Level 7 Senior Age Division Brittany Curreri of Greece placed first on vault, second in the all-around, and third on uneven bars. Mariah Burkhard of Churchville placed first on floor exercise, second on vault and balance beam, and third in the all-around. Reginna Lombardo of Greece placed first on balance beam and Sarah ten Broeke of Greece placed third on floor exercise.

In the Level 8 Junior Age Division Jessica Sullivan of Honeoye Falls placed second on balance beam and all-around, and third on uneven bars. In the Senior Age Division Julia Perry of Greece placed second on vault and Rachael Marinaccio of Webster placed second uneven bars.

In the Level 9 Senior Age Division Stasi Ozminowski of Greece placed first on floor exercise.

### *Candy Cane Classic:*

The Victors Gymnastics Team of Greece competed in the Candy Cane Classic hosted by Bright Raven Gymnastics, December 13 – 14 at SUNY Brockport. The Victors placed second overall in the Level 4 Large Team competition and third overall in the Level 5 Large Team competition.

In the 10 year old Age Division Megan Nugent of Greece placed first on vault, uneven bars, balance beam and all-around, and third on floor exercise. Ariana DiNato of Greece placed second on balance beam. In the 11 & older Age Division Ilysia Hewett of Greece placed first on vault and Kelly Urban of Greece placed second on balance beam and third in the all-around.

In the Level 5 10 year old Age Division Angel Ortiz of Gates placed second on the uneven bars. In the 11 – 12 year old Age Division Sydney Phelan of Greece placed third on the uneven bars. In the 13 and old Age Division Taylor Hoehn of Irondequoit placed first on the uneven bars, balance beam and all-around, and second on floor exercise. Miranda Morris of Irondequoit placed second on vault, balance beam, floor exercise and all-around, and third on the uneven bars.

In the Level 6 12 and old Age Division Allissa Carter of Greece place first on the balance beam and floor exercise, and second in the all-around. Carly Willmes of Webster placed second on vault and Felicia McIntyre of Greece placed second on the uneven bars and floor exercise.
